Do you have a heart for Pastoral Care? Are you inspired to build on existing Pastoral Ministries and identify and explore dynamic new ways of fulfilling the pastoral life of the Church?

Coventry and Nuneaton Methodist Circuit are seeking to appoint a highly motivated and energetic individual who, guided by the Lord, in the role of Local Lay Pastor is called to support the Pastoral care for the people of the church and the wider community.

Working collaboratively with the church leadership, alongside ministers (initially at Nuneaton Methodist Church) and within the pastoral Charge of the minister you will use strong listening and inter-personal skills to support and lead the church community to develop its pastoral care and engagement.

The appointment is for a fixed period of 3 years

21 hours per week (0.6 FTE) £24,000 - £28,008 per annum pro-rata
